## Livingston County COVID-19 Vaccination Update

Livingston County, IL –The Livingston County Health Department (LCHD) is now making appointments available for essential workers living and/or working in Livingston County. A list of essential workers who qualify in Phase 1B, directions for appointment scheduling, and links for registration are available on LCHD’s website: <https://lchd.us/site/covid-19-vaccination/>. **Only Livingston County, IL essential workers and residents age 65 and older may register at this time.**
